

Configuring your web browser to work with *Pharmacotherapy's* Atypon-Link based online journal

A common problem that subscribers run into is that they are not able to log in to our system, even after they have received a login ID and password from the system. This is usually due to the web browser not being configured properly. The steps below will help you configure your browser.

There are two settings that need to be configured: Accepting cookies and enabling pop up windows.

1. Accepting Cookies

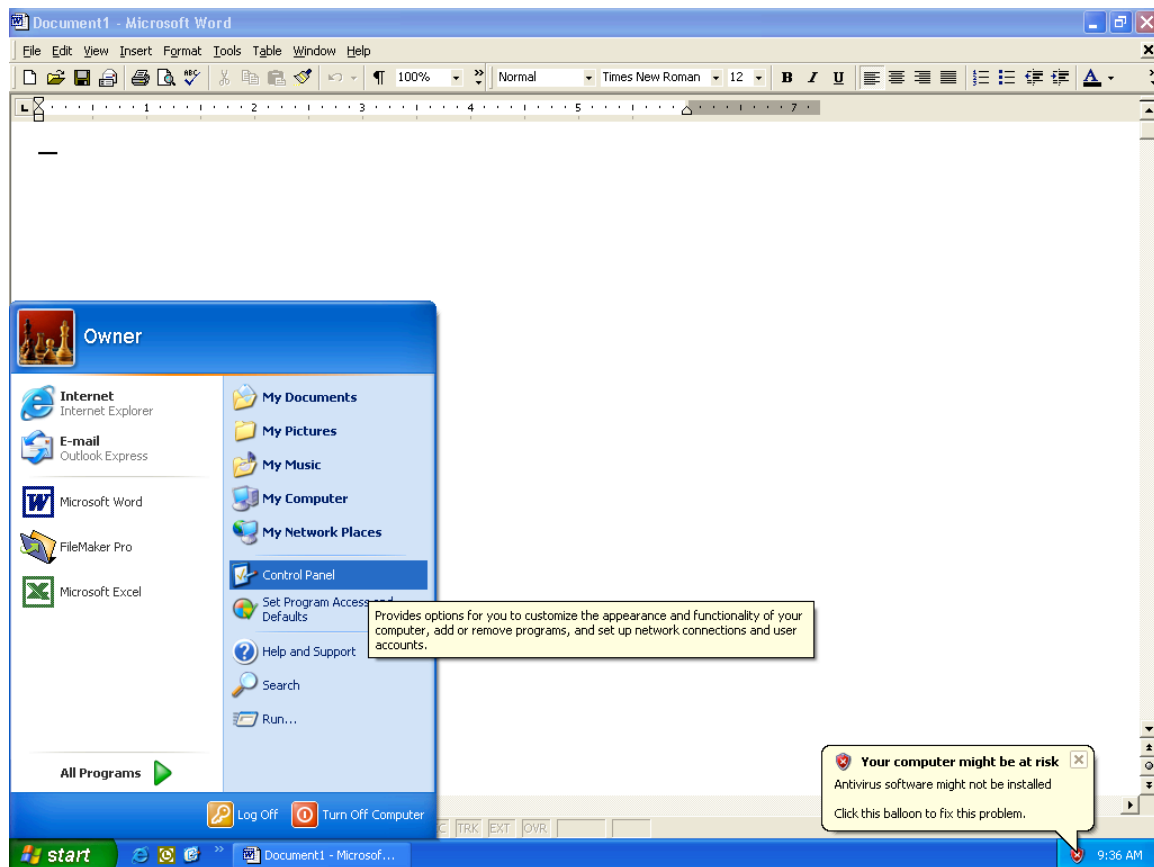


Figure 1. Accessing the Control Panels via the Start Menu

To configure cookies, go to the Start menu and Control panels as in Figure 1.

Next, Select the "Network and Internet Connections" category.

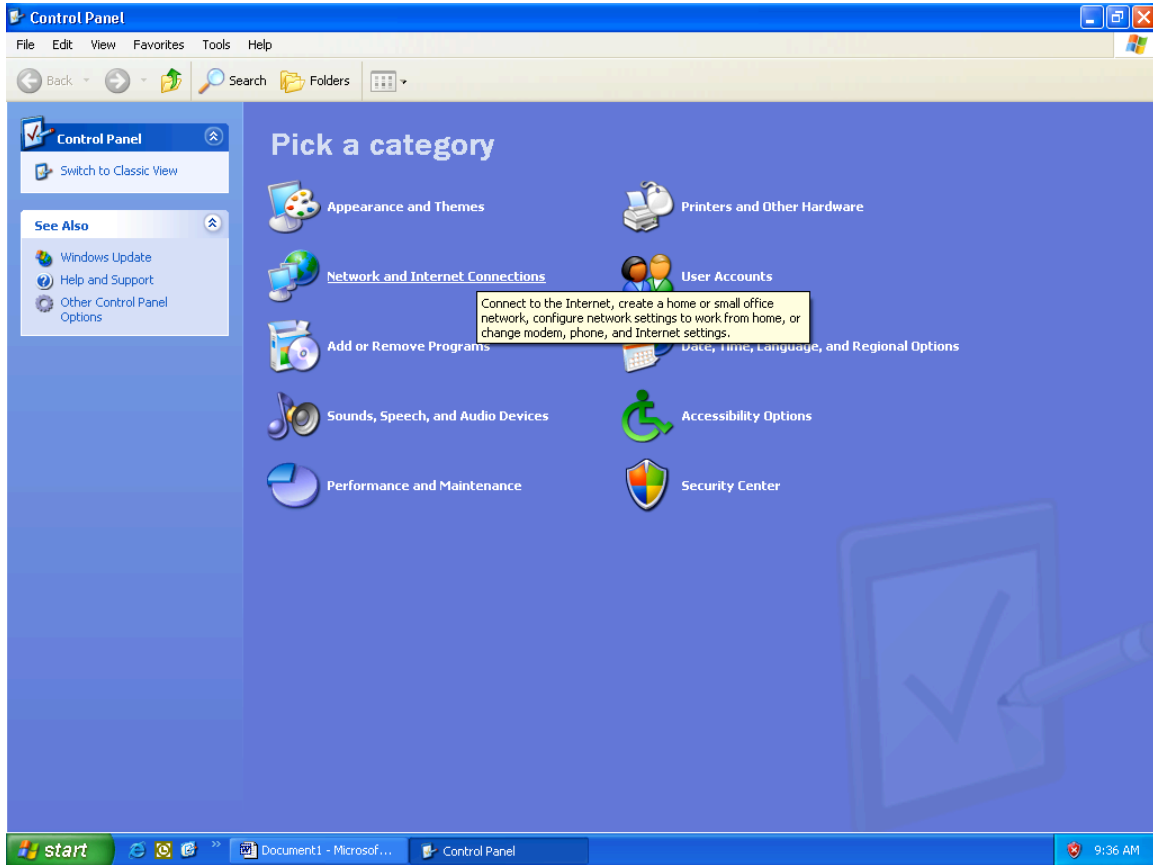


Figure 2. Control Panels in Windows XP.

Next, click on the "Internet Options" Control Panel icon.

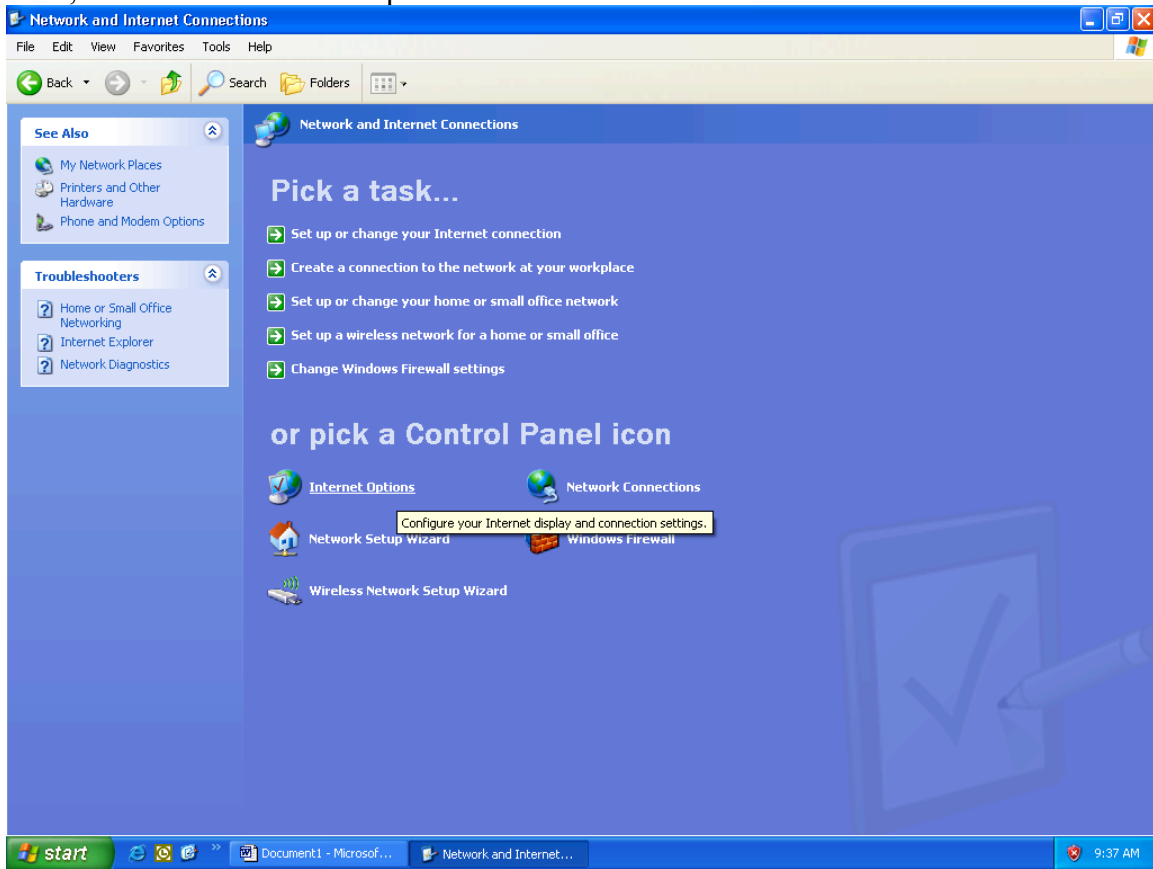


Figure 3. Control Panels in the "Network and Internet Connections" category.

Next, click on the "Privacy" tab along the top, and click on the "Sites" button in the middle of the screen.

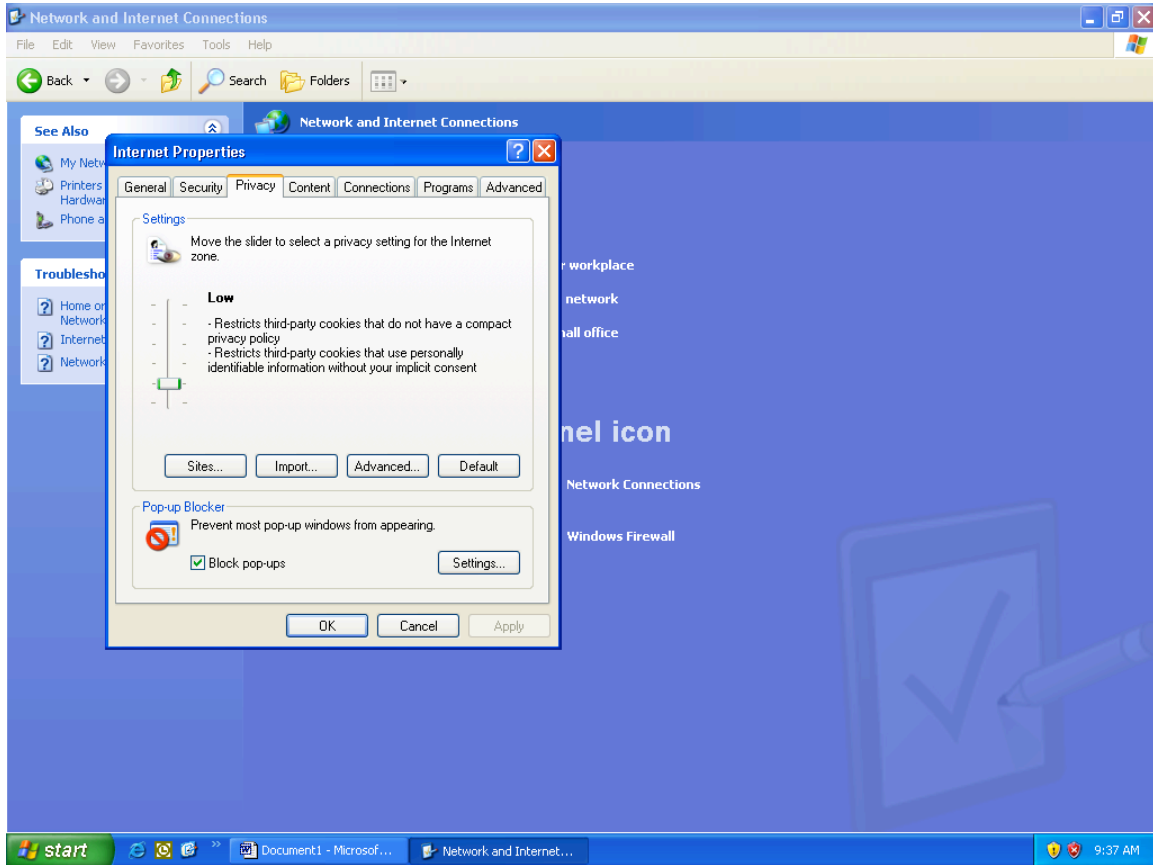


Figure 4. The Internet Options Control Panel.

This brings up the "Per Site Privacy Actions" window. Type in the site URL "http://www.atypon-link.com" and click on "Allow".

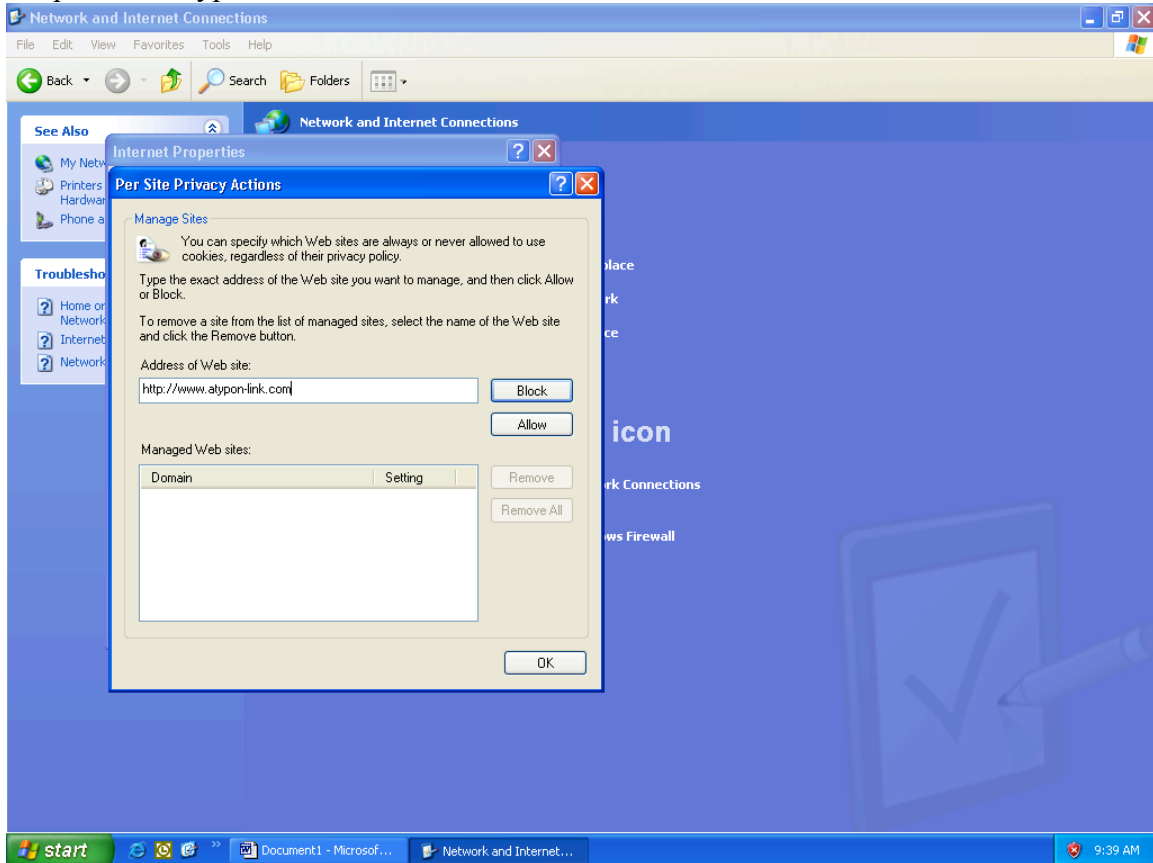


Figure 5. Per Site Privacy Actions.

Click on OK, and close the control panel windows. You should now be able to log in.

2. Pop up window controls are particular to each browser. This can also be set for particular sites in Windows XP by following the steps below:

1. Go to the Tools menu
2. Click Pop-up Blocker
3. Choose Pop-up Blocker Settings... from the Pop-up Blocker sub menu
4. Add www.atypon-link.com in Address of web site to allow
5. Click Add
6. Click Close
