

**PERMISSION REQUEST
TO USE COPYRIGHTED MATERIAL FROM**

PHARMACOTHERAPY

A quandary that faces authors is what is the proper process to include a copyrighted table or a figure from an important journal article in an article or book chapter that they are writing. A similar quandary faces educators who wish to include an entire copyrighted article in a handout, syllabus, or other teaching tool. The answer to these quandaries is dictated by copyright law. This typically involves obtaining permission from the journal and, in some instances, payment of a royalty for use of the copyrighted intellectual property.

This short, simple, user-friendly form is available on the ACCP Web site (www.accp.com) as well as in most issues of *Pharmacotherapy* (as a tear-out, faxable form). Its intent is to allow authors and educators to receive official and proper permission to use any *Pharmacotherapy* articles, tables, or figures for any educational, noncommercial application, free of charge.
